Yesterday, the <u>Honduras Human Rights and Anti-Corruption Act of 2021</u> was introduced in the United States Senate by Senator Jeff Merkley (OR). The bill calls on the United States "to suspend support for the Government of Honduras until endemic corruption, impunity, and human rights violations cease, and their perpetrators are brought to justice."

Since the 2009 military coup, Honduras has been <u>plagued by endemic corruption and rights violations</u>... ranking as the deadliest country in the world for human rights and environmental defenders on a per capita basis, and human rights violations continue unabated under the cover of COVID-19 pandemic response."

Senators Bernie Sanders (VT), Patrick Leahy (VT), Ed Markey (MA), Elizabeth Warren (MA), Dick Durbin (IL), Sheldon Whitehouse (RI) and Chris Van Hollen (MD) joined as initial cosponsors. The Bill calls for the:

- -Prohibition of US munitions exports to the Honduran police and military
- -Suspension of funding for Honduran security forces
- -Successful prosecution of all material and intellectual authors of numerous emblematic human rights cases, including the murder of Berta Cáceres
- -Sanctions for President Hernández
